

Rooted in the century-long movement that secured the right to vote for women, the League of Women Voters has worked to foster civic engagement and enhance access to the vote since our founding in 1920.

Over time our work has evolved from efforts to gain and foster women's suffrage to ensuring that all eligible voters -- particularly those from traditionally underrepresented or underserved communities, including first-time voters, non-college youth, new citizens, minorities, the elderly and voters with disabilities -- have the opportunity and the information to exercise their right to vote.

ADVOCATE for the passage of legislation that protects our voting rights, educational opportunities, natural resources, and women and family wellbeing, and increases government transparency.

COORDINATE debates across our communities at municipal and county levels of government and provide trained moderators to ensure nonpartisan discourse and promote fairness.

PROVIDE a year-round toll-free voter assistance hotline, 1-800-792-VOTE, and a website www.vote411.org, to answer voting-related questions from the public.

INTERVIEW candidates about crucial policy questions, and widely distribute this information to voters.

DISTRIBUTE the New Jersey Citizens Guide to Government, a reference book that makes it easy for New Jerseyans to learn about their government and contact their elected officials.
